## Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Issuance

**SUBJECT:** Increase of Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Advance Funding Levels available October

1, 2016 for the WIOA Title IB Dislocated Worker program

**NUMBER:** 15-05 Change 2

REFERENCE: Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA); Consolidated

**PURPOSE:** This issuance serves as official notification of the increased funding level for

the WIOA Title IB Dislocated Worker Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 "advance funds" for Program Year (PY) 2016. The worksheet used for determining the increased allocation levels for local workforce development areas (local areas)

is provided as Attachment A.

SUBSTANCE: TEGL 17-15 announced PY 2016/FY 2017 state allotments for WIOA Title IB

Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth programs.

TEGL 17-15 Change 1 announced a 0.496 percent reduction to PY 2016/FY 2017 state allotments for WIOA Title IB Adult and Dislocated Worker activities. The reduction was applied to FY 2017 advance funds distribution amounts.

TEGL 17-15 Change 2 amended the percentage reduction of FY 2017 advance funds distribution amounts. The amended, reduction percentage is 0.1901.

TEGL 24-16 announced a \$1,629 increase to Nebraska's state allotment for the WIOA Title IB Dislocated Worker activities following the recapture of excess unobligated WIOA Title IB Dislocated Worker program funds from Kentucky,

as required under WIOA Sec. 132(c).

The reductions described above do not affect the WIOA Title IB Youth activities funds (available April 1, 2016) or the base funds (available July 1, 2016) for WIOA Title IB Adult and Dislocated Worker activities.

The increase described above does not affect WIOA Title IB Youth and Adult activities funding levels, which remain as stated in Issuances 15-05 Change 1 and 16-04 Change 1, respectively.

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The increased state allotment of WIOA Title IB Dislocated Worker FY 2017 advance funds is provided in Table 1.
