CHAPTER 12 - LICENSE PROTESTS

001. This chapter is adopted pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat.* §48-1708.
002. Any individual may protest the issuance of a farm labor contractor's license to any applicant for such license. The protest may be made at any time after the license is actually issued as well as at any time prior to the issuance of the license.
003. Any individual desiring to protest the issuance of a farm labor contractor license must file the protest in writing to the Division. Hearings on protests are governed by 223 NAC 5.
004. The written protest must contain the following information:
- A. Name, address and phone number of the individual filing the protest;
 - B. Date of the protest;
 - C. Name of licensee or license applicant against whom the protest is being made;
 - D. A complete statement of the facts, circumstances and other reasons for the protest. The statement should include alleged violations, approximate dates of alleged violations, names of witnesses, if any, and any documents which support the allegations;
 - E. The signature of the individual making the protest.
