Table 1. Income Guidelines for Determination as a Low-income Individual

## For families larger than 6:

- For Nebraska Counties (not included in the Metropolitan Statistical Areas below):
  - o add \$5,084 per each additional person
- For Lincoln Metropolitan Statistical Area (Lancaster and Seward Counties):
  - o add \$5,282 per each additional person.
- For Omaha-Council Bluffs Metropolitan Statistical Area (Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, and Saunders Counties in Nebraska; Harrison, Pottawattamie, and Mills Counties in Iowa):
  - o add \$5,282 per each additional person
- For Sioux City Metropolitan Statistical Area (Dixon and Dakota Counties in Nebraska;
  Union County in South Dakota; Woodbury County in Iowa):
  - o add \$5,282 per each additional person
