EMPLOYEE NOTICE: Unemployment Insurance Benefits Eligibility

- If workers quit a job without good cause, they are not eligible for unemployment insurance benefits.
- Unemployment benefits are for those who are laid off through no fault of their own.
- Quitting work due to upcoming layoffs is generally not considered good cause for quitting under the law.
- If a worker is put in a temporary layoff status or furlough, then declines their employer's request to come back to work, the worker is generally not eligible for unemployment benefits.
