Adult and Dislocated Worker Program



Dislocated Workers

If you have been laid off or have received a layoff notice and are unlikely to return to your previous occupation or industry, you may be eligible for dislocated worker services.

Nebraska's Dislocated Worker program is a partner driven strategy that creates reemployment services and work-based trainings for eligible dislocated workers across Nebraska.

Adult Program

The Adult Program provides services for job seekers who are at least 18 years old and gives priority to low-income individuals, recipients of public assistance, and individuals lacking basic work skills. Referrals to other programs such as SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Program), TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) and others are made as appropriate.
