SUBJECT

Funding levels for WIOA Title IB adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs for Program Year (PY) 2024, July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025

PURPOSE

To provide CEOs, local boards, and local area administrative entities with PY 2024 funding levels for adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs, pursuant to Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 12-23

CHANGE

Under this notice, Table 10 has been updated to reflect accurate youth percentage allocations by local area. Youth allocation dollar amounts in Table 10 are still accurate. Also, the data in Attachment C for youth program allocations is still accurate.

ACTION

CEOs and local boards must submit the following documents by email to ndol.wioa_policy@nebraska.gov no later than July 1, 2024.¹

1. Greater Lincoln and Greater Omaha Workforce Development Boards must submit fully signed PY 2024 Grant Agreements, including Attachment I. (*Grant agreements and Attachments I are provided by the NDOL Division of Legal Services upon request to ndol.legal@nebraska.gov.*)
2. Local boards must submit PY 2024 budget plan workbooks for adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs based on funding levels described in this notice. (*Workbooks will be provided to local area administrative entity staff by email following release of this Notice.*)

NOTICE

Local area Title IB allocations are determined according to the criteria and requirements described in NDOL's policy on program funding.² As required pursuant to WIOA Secs. 128(b)(2)(A)(ii) and 133(b)(2)(A)(ii), minimum allocation requirements are in effect for:^{3,4}

- Greater Nebraska youth program;
- Greater Lincoln youth program; and
- Greater Nebraska adult program.

(a) Summary

State and local funding levels for adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs for PY 2024 are summarized in Tables 1 through 4.

¹ Documentation responsibilities for the Greater Nebraska Workforce Development Area regarding annual program funding allocations are handled separately due to the organizational structure of Greater Nebraska.
