#### **Eligibility Requirements**

There are no eligibility requirements.

#### CONNECT

CONNECT is an industry-driven strategy that focuses on the reemployment of long-term unemployed workers and bridges the skills and education gaps between the available workforce and employment positions in the Information Technology (IT) industry. Through a combination of education and work-based training programs, CONNECT provides structured training opportunities in which participants gain the knowledge, competencies, and abilities necessary to be successful in the IT industry. Eligible individuals can participate in paid on-the-job training programs, paid internships, and other earn-and-learn opportunities.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- 18 years or older
- High school diploma or GED equivalent

**AND** if either of the following apply, you may qualify for CONNECT:

- Long-term Unemployed Unemployed 27 weeks or more and are available for full-time work
- Underemployed Lost job during recent recession or shortly after (Dec. 2007 Dec. 2010) and have obtained short-term or part-time employment that does not match your education, skills, and previous salary



NCBVI operates a comprehensive and coordinated program designed to assist individuals who are blind to gain remunerative employment, enlarge economic opportunities, increase the range and diversity of available occupations, stimulate other efforts that aid blind persons in becoming self-supporting, and provide training in the skills of blindness for independent living.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

Must be legally blind or have sight which is so defective as to seriously limit the ability to engage in ordinary vocations and daily activities of life. The individual must be a U.S Citizen or legal alien, physically present in Nebraska and must require rehabilitation services to achieve their vocational or independent living goals.

Job Seekers Programs

#### Nebraska VR

Nebraska VR offers assistance to individuals with disabilities get jobs or advance in their careers. Clients meet with a counselor and develop a work plan. Services can include career planning, training, job placement, on the job supports, and counseling.

People with disabilities who want to work (16 and older).

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- **ESL** must be 18 and NOT enrolled in High School (no fee)
- GED special requirements for individuals 16 & 17 years old. (no fee for classes- but test fee)
- **Citizenship** no requirement
- Spanish Class no requirements (fee required)
- Family Literacy Must be between the ages of 4 and 12 years old

### **Eligibility Requirements**

Eligibility is based on federal regulations regarding citizenship status and income, as well as a computer generated random selection process.

Project help provides success and career coaching, tuition scholarships, uniforms, class supplies, laptops gas cards for educational and job search purposes, success planning and information regarding community referrals.


Primarily provides services to able bodied adults without dependents. Enrolls adults with children who are not receiving cash assistance.

## **Trade Act Programs**

The Trade Act programs, Trade
Adjustment Assistance (TAA) and
Reemployment Trade Adjustment
Assistance (RTAA), assist individuals
who have become unemployed as
a result of increased imports from,
or shifts in production to, foreign
countries. The goal of the Trade Act
programs is to help trade-affected
workers return to suitable employment
as quickly as possible. To facilitate
this goal, TAA certified workers may
access a menu of services that include
income support, relocation allowances,

job search allowances, and a health coverage tax credit (HCTC). TAA participants that require retraining in order to obtain suitable employment may receive occupational training.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

#### **2017 MONETARY REQUIREMENTS**

- Minimum earnings of \$4145.75 in the base period.
- At least one base period quarter containing \$1850
- Another base period quarter containing \$800
- Separation of employment do to no fault of the worker
