## Rules and Regulations

All rules and regulations can be found in the [Nebraska Amusement Ride Act](#) and the related *Nebraska Administrative Code, Title 228 Rules and Regulations, Chapters 1-44* which have been adopted pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat. §48-1803*. Please review these chapters as they contain useful information on how to establish your operators training and checklist. There are other items listed in the various chapters you must be familiar with in order to operate amusement rides in Nebraska.

The requirements below apply to all amusement rides previously permitted in the state, and to all new rides being brought into the state. **Please note that only after all requirements of the pre-inspection checklist are received will an inspection be scheduled.**

### Required with Permit Application:

1. Non-destructive test reports on rides that require NDT'S (48-1803);
2. Completed amusement ride route listing form (48-1814);
3. List of trained ride operators and each ride they are certified to operate;
4. Written Ride Operating Policy (Title 228 – Ch.40-003);
5. Proof of Liability Insurance (If event provides insurance, each ride must be re-inspected and re-permitted by a State of Nebraska amusement ride inspector.) (48-1806, Title 228 Ch.2-005).

### Required to Produce at Time of Inspection:

6. Each ride's manufacturer's operating / installation manual (electronic format is ok) (48-1803);
  - All inspections will be performed based on the operator's manual for the ride, otherwise an inspection cannot be performed on that ride.
7. Your copy of the *Nebraska Amusement Ride Act-Title 228 Rules and Regulations Chapter 1-44 (Title 228-Ch.40)*;
8. Up-to-date maintenance and inspection records on each amusement ride (48-1813).
9. Payment to Nebraska Department of Labor. Please note that the Amusement Ride Inspection program no longer accepts cash payments. Cashier's checks or money orders made out to Nebraska Department of Labor will be accepted.
