### SUBJECT

Funding levels for WIOA Title I adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs for Program Year (PY) 2023, July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024

### PURPOSE

To provide CEOs, local boards, and local area administrative entities with PY 2023 funding levels for adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs, pursuant to Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 15-22

## CHANGE

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This Change 1 establishes a material change to the superseded and canceled notice. Column 2 in Table 8 has been revised to reflect correct allocation percentages for local Title I dislocated worker programs. Dollar amounts in Table 8 are not affected by this correction.

## ACTION

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This Change 1 supersedes and cancels Notice 22-04 (effective May 24, 2023).

CEOs and local boards must submit the following documents by email to [ndol.wioa\\_policy@nebraska.gov](mailto:ndol.wioa_policy@nebraska.gov) no later than July 1, 2023.<sup>1</sup>

1. Greater Lincoln and Greater Omaha Workforce Development Boards must individually submit a fully signed PY 2023 WIOA Grant Agreement and PY 2023 WIOA Grant Agreement Attachment I, Assurances.
2. Greater Lincoln and Greater Omaha Workforce Development Boards must individually submit fully completed PY 2023 budget plan workbooks for their respective local adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs based on the funding levels described in this Notice.

The required forms for paragraphs 1 and 2 will be provided by email to local area administrative entity staff following publication of this Notice.

## NOTICE

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Local area allocations are determined according to the criteria and requirements described in the State's current policy on program funding.<sup>2</sup> As required pursuant to WIOA Secs. 128(b)(2)(A)(ii) and 133(b)(2)(A)(ii), minimum allocation requirements are in effect for the:<sup>3,4</sup>

- Greater Nebraska for the youth program;
- Greater Lincoln for the youth program;
- Greater Nebraska for the adult program;
