- 1. The right to organize;
- 2. The right to a safe workplace;
- **3.** The right to adequate facilities and the opportunity to use them;
- 4. The right to complete information;
- 5. The right to understand the information provided;
- 6. The right to existing state and federal benefits and rights;
- 7. The right to be free from discrimination;
- The right to continuing training, including training of supervisors;
- 9. The right to compensation for work performed; and
- **10.** The right to seek state help.
