## Who is a dislocated worker?

A dislocated worker is someone who has been **laid off or has received a layoff notice** from their employer, *and* who is **unlikely to find employment again in their previous occupation** or industry.

A person can become displaced for many reasons. Some of those reasons may include:

- The demand for their skills has been reduced due to automation.
- Their employer is going out of business, moving to a new location, or merging with another business.
- They are the spouse of an active-duty service member who was forced to relocate.

### Career Coaching

We provide individual support to help you build a plan that fits your goals, interests, and needs.
